### Yard Pastor Elena Hernandez—JUNE 2022 REPORT



**Teaching a Bible study to the women at the Rehab Door to Heaven in San Jacinto, B.C.**

Thank you very much to all the people who support me with your finances through the Pastors to Prisoners Organization. I am very grateful for your support! I pray that the Lord will reward you richly for your generosity.

**UPDATE ON THE “DOOR TO HEAVEN” WOMEN’S REHAB:** The center is full right now with 24 women. Many parents come desperately seeking help for their daughters who at a young age are already addicted to drugs or alcohol. The Rehab does not have the answer to their problems, but God does. This is a spiritual warfare that only through continuous ministering of the Word of God that chains of addiction can be broken. Nothing else would work: Psychiatrist, witchcraft, religion, sacrifices and offerings – nothing works. Only through the Spirit of God addictions can be broken. During the last week of June one case of COVID showed up in one of the women so the classes are suspended temporarily.

**UPDATE ON THE “LIVING WITH HOPE” MEN’S REHAB:** I have been teaching a Bible study every Wednesday morning to the men in the rehab, but I got infected with COVID on June 24 and had to stop ministering temporarily. Some of the staff members have also been infected with COVID and don’t know when this is going to end.

Please pray for the men and women in recovery. One of the most challenging things that the center encounters is the daily feeding of 120 men and 24 women. The money that they pay at their arrival in Reception is minimal and some men cannot afford to pay anything. Pastor Antonio Hernandez receives them anyway, saying that this is not a lucrative center, this is a ministry from God and that God will supply all their needs according to his riches in glory. ## INSTALLING SOLAR LIGHTS TO FAMILIES LIVING IN LAS AVES



This is Anita, an 11 year old girl who lives with her 55 year old grandmother. Her mother left to the U.S. seeking a better job when Anita was 4 years old but she never came back nor calls or sends money for her support. Petra, the grandmother, works picking up strawberries in the fields to support Anita. They live in this modest shack with no electricity. But this month we were able to install solar lights inside their home. Anita's birthday is on November 3. If you wish to send her a gift for her birthday, please let me know. She is going to start school in August, and some school supplies and backpack will probably make her very happy. Thank you!



This is Esther with her three children plus one older boy who was at school at the time of our visit. Her husband works in the strawberry fields and she stays home taking care of the children. Thank God we were able to install solar lights in her modest shack where she lives with her husband and children. When asked what was her immediate need, she said blankets, because they only have two blankets. Some shoes and clothing for the children are also needed.



A family of eight people lived in this small shack. Two adults and six children. The oldest child takes care of all the children while their parents go to work. Seen in the left picture are two of the children playing in the small shack. The family was very grateful that we were able to install solar lights their week. - 5) Many windows are broken in all the men's buildings and financial help is needed to buy new windows.
